
Chem eStandards 5.4

 - Added support for additional ingredient information required for product blends
 - Added support for additional product information in the PriceAndAvailabilityResponse message
- Addressed a few bugs (no impact on backwards compatibility; no impact on instance documents)

JSON NDR and REST API Design Guide

- JSON NDR references UN/CEFACT CCTS and NDR
- Changed Camel Case to Lower for best practices
- Made allowances for no attributes in JSON
- OAGi endorses the OData URI convention for resource paths and query options, reflecting the goals of the Richardson Maturity Model
- The BOD architecture is NOT planned to be used at this time. The focus is on using Nouns and Components for the data definitions
- The Verbs used for OAGIS JSON Schema API's or messages uses the REST mechanism verbs in lieu of the OAGIS Verbs.

- ISA-95 Chair is now part of the Quality Content WG






Current Release OAGIS 10.1

- Released in July, 2014
- Mostly based on feedback from several of our members implementing OAGIS 10.0
- OAGIS 10.1 is backwardly compatible with OAGIS Release 10.0.
- Added an Intermediary area with 0 to infinite cardinality to the Application area to support Mobile and Cloud Computing as well as to support complex logistics. The Intermediary is designed to be the Senders' and Receivers' steps along the way to the Final Receiver in the path
- Added the FinancialAccount and References Groups to PartyMaster, SupplierPartyMaster and CustomerPartyMaster
- Added ReceiptDiscrepancy capability to describe the issue to ReceiveDeliveryItemType
- Added an OAGIS Test Request on the Inspect Delivery Line




OAGI OAGIS 10.1 Changed BOD Architecture







OAGI OAGIS 10.X The Way Forward


- The OAGIS Cloud, Mobile, ISON work will be OAGIS Release 10.x based

- All new technology and content enhancements will go into OAGIS Release 10.x
- It is the platform of the future for OAGIS






The Model

- All of building blocks
 - The Platform
 - The Meta Model
 - BOD Architecture
 - Messaging Architecture
 - Nouns
 - Verbs
- The "OAGIS Standard Edition" is a set of generated expressions from the model
- Enables Contextualized Versions all based on same model
- Enables generating of other expressions such as JSON while maintaining the normative Model






Model Concept


